Sancton Wood School GCSE Results 2016

2016 was a stellar year for our 16 students who sat their GCSEs and IGCSEs. Our pupils sat exams in 16 subjects and achieved 45% A* and A grades.

100% of our students achieved 5 or more A* - C grade GCSEs including Maths and English. One student gained a collection of A* and A grades in 11 subjects, including Drama, Biology and History, whilst another achieved full marks for their English Language paper.

This year our GCSE Value Added scores were hugely encouraging; these scores, based on predictions made when the students were in Year 7, showed that everyone exceeded their 5 A* to C grade predictions, some by a large percentage. The predictions set in Year 7 showed 56% were expected to gain 5 A* - C grades including English and Maths; our achievement of 100% represents an impressive 44% improvement.

This strong showing is testament to the dedication of our staff, the application and hard work of the students and the importance of an inclusive, supportive ethos.
