Start point. The junction of Woodhead Drive & College Fields but realistically you can start at any point on the route & go either forwards or backwards through the clues. Each clue results in achieving one letter towards solving the final phrase. Some locations for the clues are given, some you may have to use local knowledge or the internet. Some clues are very near each other but some are further away so you can get up some speed. The clues are not too difficult so should be fun for all the family.

- 1. As you turn into Downhams Lane, look back. What letter is on the 2 street signs that you have just passed through?
- 2. Turning right onto Milton Rd, there is a postbox. On it, what is the first letter on the white sign?
- 3. The letter etched at the bottom of the heart on the 'We love the NHS' sign at The Milton Arms.
- 4. The first letter on the door of Cambridge Floral Designs.
- 5. At the roundabout at the end of Highworth Avenue, what is the first letter on the sign where a bike, an adult and a child appear.
- 6. The first letter of the store between Subway and The Whacky Hair Company.
- 7. The letter after the 'missing letter' on the place where clothes are washed near Mitcham's Corner.
- 8. The Roman numeral that represents the missing house number at the roundabout end of Short Street. There are only 9 houses in the street.
- 9. The 2nd letter of the bank situated between Clamp Optometrists and Jones Bootmaker.
- 10. At Lensfield Rd cycles, which letter of the shop title is represented by an illustration.
- 11. Opposite the Lensfield Hotel, which letter is not permitted according to the road sign.
- 12. Where St Paul's Rd meets Hills Rd, what is the 2nd letter of the country where the milk is made that is supplied by Bull's Dairies?
- 13. At Prowler House, the 1st letter of the bottom one of the 3 companies that reside there.
- 14. From the same spot, which letter is missing from a street name suggesting there is a superhero living there?
- 15. Opposite 90 Hills Rd, take the last letter of the establishment's owners name that should fill you with happiness & love.

- 16. At The Stephen Perse nursery, add the last 2 digits of the phone number & translate it into a letter e.g A=1, B=2 etc.
- 17. From the same spot, where brilliance happens in Cambridge, add the digits from the earliest date and translate them in the same way.
- 18. At 72 St Barnabas Rd, take the only letter that appears twice on the sign of the loft conversion companies name.
- 19. The letter on the sign that appears to stick out of the post box where Gwydir St meets Mill Rd.
- 20. The 2nd letter of the famous store that used to be at 38 Mill Rd.
- 21. The last letter of the company that wishes to 'Let' 2 Mill Rd.
- 22. The letter above Centre Point in East Rd.
- 23. The first letter of the name of the animal appearing on the pub sign of The Tram Depot.
- 24. The letter missing from OKOKO at 48 Burleigh St.
- 25. The 2nd of the missing 2 letters of the bald man's bookmakers in the same street.
- 26. The first letter of the Travel Agent opposite Wilko.
- 27. Where a zebra used to be (and in some ways, still is), what is the 1st letter of the only word on their front door?
- 28. The first letter of the number of black letter boxes at 1 Wellington Court.
- 29. At Cambridge Dental Hub, what is the last letter of the missing word? Emergency, Restorative,, Implants, Hygenest.
- 30. The 2nd letter of the name of the store between Furniture Village & Dunelm.
- 31. The 1st letter of the word under Currys & PC World.
- 32. The first letter of the last word seen on the tall Tesco sign as you turn in to Cheddars Lane from Newmarket Rd.

If you solved every clue then you should now have 32 letters. You need to re-arrange them to make a phrase relevant to this day & age.
